

What is the ADA National Network?

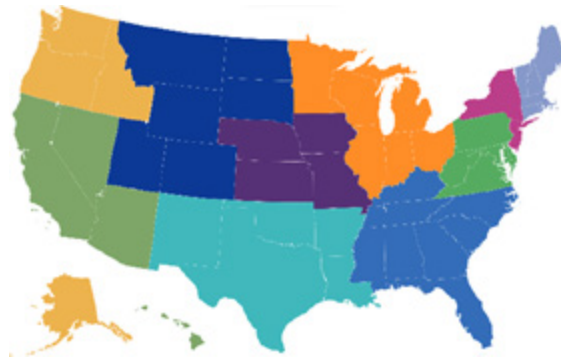
The ADA National Network provides information, guidance, and training on the ADA to support the mission of the ADA to “assure equality of opportunity, full participation, independent living, and economic self-sufficiency for individuals with disabilities.” There are 10 regional ADA Centers, each focusing on its region’s unique needs. The ADA National Network also includes a national Knowledge Translation Center and a collaborative research project known as ADA PARC.

We help everyone understand the ADA. This includes people with disabilities whose rights are protected under the ADA, and those with responsibilities like businesses, employers, state and local governments, architects, and non-profits. We do not enforce the law. We are a helpful resource supporting the ADA’s mission to “make it possible for everyone with a disability to live a life of freedom and equality.”
